UNIVERSITIES ACT, No. 16 OF 1978

Order under Section 25A

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 25A of the Universities Act, No. 16 of 1978, I, Dr. Bandula Gunawardana, the Minister of Higher Education, Technology and Innovation, having obtained a report under Sectioin 70C of the aforesaid Act, in respect of the Institute of Chemistry, Ceylon, established under the Institute of Chemisty, Ceylon, Act, No. 15 of 1972, do by this Order and subject to the conditions specified in Schedule I hereto, recognize the Institute of Chemistry, Ceylon as a Degree Awarding Institute for the purpose of developing Higher Education therein, leading to the award of the Degree specified in Column I of the Schedule II hereto, of which the abbreviation is set out in the corresponding entry in Column II of the Schedule II hereto:

SCHEDULE I

Conditions

- 1. Institute of Chemistry, Ceylon shall conduct the degree programmes relevant to the Degree specified in Schedule II hereto, only at Adamantane House, Kotte Road, Welikada, Rajagiriya.
- 2. Institute of Chemistry, Ceylon is allowed to offer the Degree specified in Schedule II hereto, subject to the programme re-review to be conducted by the Specified Authority.



SCHEDULE I (Contd.)

3. Institute of Chemistry, Ceylon shall, when admitting students for the degree programmes relevant to the Degree specified in Schedle II hereto, in respect of the Bachelor of Science Honours in Chemical Science, adhere to the minimum entry qualifications of three (3) simple passes ("S") in biological science or physical science subject stream in one and the same sitting at the GCE (Advanced Level) Examination or equivalent.
